

You will be reading Chapters 1 − 5 of this book. As you read, you will be keeping a response log. This may be done in any kind of notebook, or on binder paper. It must be **handwritten in ink**, and not typed. Bring your log to class on the first day of school, along with the separate worksheet and the rest of the summer assignments.

- The entire first page of your response log needs to be a Title Page. (We trust that you know what to include.)
- After that, as you start each chapter please indicate the chapter number and title in your log.
- Be sure to write down each section heading as you come to it.
- Create a **narrow** column on the left side of each page. Here you will write what you are responding to (a passage, an idea, a topic, a question you have) and the page number.

Note: We are NOT interested in your assessment of the author's writing style! We are interested in historical content and ideas.

• On the right side, write your thoughtful response to the thing you have recorded on the left. This should be several sentences.

Note: Your writing should take up more space than the quote you are responding to.

• Try to pick out several passages from each chapter to record and respond to.

We understand that this book is time-consuming to read, but you do need to devote your attention to doing so carefully. It will give you an excellent foundation, and start you off on the path to passing the AP Exam.
