

€ 1816 → American Colonization Society created (gradual, voluntary emancipation.

Abolitionist Movement

- Create a free slave state in Liberia, West Africa.
- No real anti-slavery sentiment in the North in the 1820s & 1830s.

C is the Cotton-field, to which This injured brother's driven, When, as the white man's slave, he toils From early morn till even.




D is the Driver, cold and stern,

William Lloyd Garrison (1801–1879)




- Slavery & Masonry undermined republican values.




Premiere issue → January 1, 1831


The Tree of Slavery—Loaded with the Sum of All Villanies!








1829 → Appeal to the Coloured

Fight for freedom rather than wait to be set free by whites.


Frederick Douglass (1817–189<u>5)</u>
