

APUSH Review One-Pagers 2016
Units One & Nine: 10 points each
Units Two - Eight: 15 points each
Units 7A & 7B are separate
10 points for having all of them, done on time

You will be preparing a one-page summary for each unit we have studied. The design of these summaries is up to you, but there are several requirements:

- You must use **unlined, oversized** paper (at least 8 1/2 x 14.)
(if typing, go to “page setup” and choose “legal size” to format & print on this size)
- You must put the Unit # and Title at the top.
- You must put your name, the date, and period where it is easy to find.

The contents must include **all** of the following, however you want to arrange and present them:

- the years covered
- key presidents who served during those years, and their political parties (Units 3 - 9)
(include just the most significant ones - don't spend too much space)
- foreign policies and key events (for Colonial Era, consider relations/trade with Britain, Native Americans & other nations)
- domestic policies and key events
- key court cases (by name, date, and significance)
- important documents (speeches, letters, treaties, songs, etc.)
- **several** significant images
- the most influential people (besides the presidents)
- EACH ITEM LISTED ABOVE SHOULD INCLUDE A VERY BRIEF INDICATION OF WHAT IS SIGNIFICANT ABOUT IT
- **Finally, but very importantly, find a way to identify key TRENDS or developments that you detect. in the unit. You are looking for changes in American society, or government, or in our relationship to the rest of the world.**

Organize your page in such a way that it is easy to understand (and read). Make it look nice for more points. Remember, this packet of pages is worth 150 points total, and it should look like you put some time into it. It also needs to be easy to study from.

In preparing your one-pagers, it is important that you make your own selections about what to include (as the decision-making will greatly increase your memory of the material). Working **with** others is great - discussing will also boost your understanding and memory. Just copying someone else's choices is a waste of time.
