Visits to the Superior Court of California Santa Clara County

Court is in session M – F, 8:30 am – 4:00 pm, or until the judge decides to recess.... HOWEVER, you will <u>not</u> receive credit for any court visits that take place when you are supposed to be in school!

You will have to pass through security when you enter the court, including a metal detector, and your belongings will be screened. (Don't be carrying anything you shouldn't have.)

There are dress codes for court – no shorts, flip-flops, bare midriffs, etc. It is best to follow the school dress code.

If you are going to San Jose, be prepared to pay for parking (coins for the meter, or dollars for a lot).

<u>Of course</u>, be on your best, most mature behavior. Don't flirt with the convicts, don't snicker at the testimony, and don't make any jokes about being a terrorist!

After you pass through the metal detector, there will be a sheriff's desk. Ask there for directions to an active courtroom, and even for suggestions. This is also where you will get your verification of attendance signed (on the way in <u>and</u>out).
