Background: 1 - 3 sentences briefly summarize why the situation has come up Thesis Paragraph Thesis statement: 1 sentence addresses the full prompt, and takes a clear position Preview: 1 sentence the major reasons your thesis is right, in the order in which you will address them First major reason your thesis is right. First Body Explanation Paragraph **Details** Examples Second major reason your thesis is right. Explanation Second Body Paragraph Details Examples Third <u>major</u> reason your thesis is right. Third Body Explanation **Details** Paragraph (if appropriate) Examples Revisits and confirms the thesis, but does not just restate it. Conclusion Ties in to <u>future</u> developments, or the larger picture. Puts the topic in perspective.
